One 12 change that was brought up was to add the words "next after the August annual meeting" in 13 Section 8 at the end of the paragraph. 14 15 16 A Motion was made by Bob to add that change, seconded by Kari, unanimous approval. 17 18 A Motion Was made by Bob to send the recommended change back to the CRC, seconded by Kari, unanimous approval. 19 20 21 Motion to Suspend the meeting by Bob, seconded by Gerry at 7:36, unanimous approval. 22 23 Motion to Reconvene the meeting by Tom, seconded by Gerry at 7:40, unanimous approval. 24 25 Motion to Accept the amended CRC Final Report by Kari, seconded by Tom, unanimous approval. 26 27 Motion to disband the CRC Committee by Tom, seconded by Kari, unanimous approval. 28 29 Motion to Submit the CRC Final Report to a vote of the Electorate and provide appropriate legal notice of the same by Kari, seconded by Tom, unanimous approval. 30 31 32 Conversation between members as to the Ballots, and mailings, and newspaper publication. It was determined that 244 Ballots would be mailed, each ballot would be marked so that duplicate 33 copies could not be made, and the ballots would still be anonymous.
