
Lowering of the Lake

Safe Boating/Personal Watercraft Certification

LCIA has scheduled a Safe Boating/Personal Watercraft Certification class.

WHEN: March 25, 2006 – 8 am to 4 pm WHERE: LCIA, Chaffee Hall, 15 Old Town Road, Ashford, CT

Preregistration is preferred. Please contact Laura Koropatkin at 487-3595 or 871-0327 to register. This is a one-day course to obtain a Connecticut certificate of watercraft operation required by Connecticut State Law. A SAFE boating certificate is required at the age of 12 and older.

DRÍVEWAY ORDINANCE

LC 89-7 No approach or driveway to any street or road maintained by the Lake Chaffee Improvement Association, Inc. shall be constructed or existing driveways improved unless a permit is first issued by the Board of Directors or its agent.

The landowner or agent shall install all drainage pipes, culverts, headwalls, catch basins, and ditches, and perform any grading deemed necessary by the Board of Directors or agent to protect the abutting Association road or street.


The landowner or agent shall be liable for any damage done to any Association road or street in the construction of such approach.

The Board of Directors or its agents will require a \$500.00 cash deposit to sufficiently insure completion of construction.

All permits shall expire twelve (12) months from the date of issue unless renewed by the Board of Directors or its agent and all construction must be completed before its expiration.

Any driveway with a grade downward toward an Association road or street must be oiled or paved.

Any person, firm, or corporation who violates any part of this ordinance shall be FINE: \$100.00.





As you conscientious lake dwellers are probably already aware, the lake is a living organism like the human body. In order to maintain a healthy lake we need to be concious about what we put into it.


From the tiniest microscopic plant or animal to the biggest snapping turtle and catfish, every living thing in the lake is part of a strictly balanced ecosystem. A little too much lawn fertilizer may not hurt your lawn but it can create all kinds of problems in the lake by upsetting the nitrogen and phosphorous balance leading to an overgrowth of brown algae.

Even the soap we use to wash our beloved vehicles on the streets around the lake ends up washing into the catch hasins which eventually empty into the lake. Right now our lake is pretty healthy. Here are some suggestions we can use to keep it that

Don't blow soil, grass or leaves into the street, catch basins, or lake. Soil and sediment can cloud the water making it difficult for plant and animal life to grow.

Pet waste and faulty septic systems contribute to fecal coliform caontamination. Pick up after your pets and throw pet waste into the garbage. Have septic tanks pumped every three to five years to prevent leaking.

Reep your car working properly so that motor oil and car fluids don't leak onto roads and wash into the lake during storm runoff.

Wash your car at a commercial car wash where wastewater is captured and treated or use ecologically safe products and wash your car on the lawn.

To keep the lake ecosystem free of invasive plant species, please follow these simple steps:

- After using marine equipment at any other recreational area remove all visible mud, plants or animals (i.e., snails, harnacles).
 - Completely drain all water from the hull, bilge, wells and trailer. Clean and dry allclothing and equipment.

Only release the plants, fish, animals back into the body of water from where they came.

And of course, never dump any aquarium water into or near the lake. Beautiful ornamental aquarium foliage is harmless in the fish tank but deadly to the native plant and animal life of

VEHICLE ORDINANCES

LC 89-9 Speed limit of 15 miles per hour on all roads controlled by the Association, MAXIMUM FINE: \$50.00.

LC 89-9-1 No parking on Association roads at any time. This will be considered as obstructing traffic. Each day will be treated as a separate occurrence. FINE: \$10.00.

I.C 89-9-2 No parking at any time on Association property with the exception of Chaffee Hall. Vehicles will be towed at owner's expense.
FINE: \$25.00.

LC 89-9-3 No unregistered motor vehicles shall be allowed on Association roads and/or property. Any motor vehicle owner and/or operator who violates the above shall be FINED \$50.00 for each offense and every 24 hours of continuance shall be deemed a separate offense.*

LC 89-9-4 No motor vehicle shall be operated except on established Association roads. Any person who operates a motor vehicle in violation of the above shall be FINED \$50.00 for each offense.*

LC 89-9-5 Any vehicle using Association roads and/or property and weighing more than 20,000 lbs, gross vehicle weight must post a \$500.00 cash deposit to insure reparations to the Association in the event said vehicle causes damage to Association roads and/or property.

Said deposit is to remain in effect for as long as the said vehicle is using Association roads and/or property. Said deposit may be refunded only upon presenting to the Association satisfactory proof that said vehicle is no longer using Association roads and/or property.

Any vehicle using Association roads and/or property without having the required \$500.00 cash deposit, shall be subject to a FINE of \$50.00 for each offense, except for any services contracted by the Lake Chaffee Improvement Association, Inc., heating oil delivery trucks, and honey wagons.*

* The definition of "Motor Vehicle" is the same as that used in the Connecticut General Statutes Section 14-1(26).
